

Cookies

In accordance with the provisions of Sect. 89 of Act No. 127/2005 Coll., on electronic communications, we hereby inform you that our servers use cookies for their activities.

Cookies are usually very small data files/records that your browser creates and stores on your PC according to instructions from the website you are viewing, if it is programmed to use cookies. The next time you visit this site, this site will request its stored cookies from your browser and read the information in them.

The website will record various information in the cookie, such as your preferred settings. Cookies are not used to collect sensitive personal data or to identify you as a specific person, but they are important for privacy protection.

If your browser has cookies enabled, we will assume that you agree to the use of cookies on our servers.

1. Types of cookies

- a) temporary cookies that are only stored until the browser session ends
- b) persistent cookies that remain stored even after the browser session is closed

Temporary cookies store useful information for the session, ensuring that the browser remembers the current settings and does not need to be re-entered after each visit.

Persistent cookies generally identify the browser when it returns to a website, store "persistent" settings for a particular website, etc.

2. What do we use them for?

- a) to store settings that affect the appearance and behaviour of the website.
- b) to keep statistics, to measure traffic.

Our website may be an intermediary for storing third-party cookies (e.g. we use Google Analytics to measure traffic). We have no influence on the creation of these cookies, we cannot read them and we do not have access to them.
